

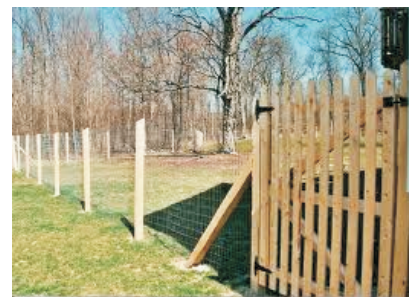


## Farm fence Product information

3&4 rail farm fence is installed with a true 1x6x16 rough cut farm fence board and 4x4x7 rough cut post to match. This wood is especially made for this type of fencing (we do not use deck boards). Everything is nailed with a ring shank galvanized nail to prevent backing out or rust. All post are set in concrete.



Our 12ga galvanized welded wire is made to prevent rust. We carry a 2x4 wire that is made especially for horses to keep them from getting there hooves caught incase they were to kick the fence.



Our 2&3 rail split rail farm fence is constructed with 10' long cedar split rail boards and cedar split rail post. This particular fence does not use nails and all post are set in concrete.



Our PVC/ Vinyl Farm Fence is made to prevent future maintenance is very strong when installed correctly and carries a manufacturer limited lifetime warranty.

#### Top two questions to ask.

**#1** Can we have a copy of your contractors License.

The **State of Tennessee** requires a license in order to check bank accounts to help reduce the chance of someone taking advantage of you.

To also check insurance to make sure your protected from getting sued by one of their employees or sub contractors if they were to get hurt on your property. And to make sure that you are covered if damage is done to your property.

**#2** Do you carry at least a **2 year workmanship warranty**.

If a company or one of their workers put metal nails or straight nails in your fence they will rust and or back out. (We see this all the time!) There are lots and lots of small things that really matter where quality is concerned.

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## **Fence Installation and what to expect**

**Please Take a moment to read our what to expect.**

Thank You for choosing K & C Fence Company. We are very grateful for the opportunity to be able to serve you!

### **We wanted to take just a moment and let you know what to expect when having a fence constructed on your property.**

- 1:** We must carry material back and forth and can cause some wear on the grass. (please give some time for the grass to recuperate).
- 2:** We have to dig up dirt and will have left over dirt on the property. We will make a effort to spread the dirt out, but depending on the dirt condition or rock that is present, the dirt and or rock may not spread evenly. (please give sometime for the grass to recuperate and take over the new dirt) There may be some ground work to do after fence construction has taken place on your property. Rock can not be removed from the property.
- 3:** Wood fencing is a natural product and is subject to twist, shrink, warp, crack and or rot.
- 4:** All wood gates are subject to sag as the wood moves. (if you have not been given the option of a metal gate frame to help with this problem please contact your estimator).
- 5:** Your estimator can be working with numerous customers at one time. Our goal is to provide a constant ability to communicate. If you have any questions please feel free contact your estimator to communicate any questions or concerns you may have before or during your fence installation process.
- 6:** We are always trying to get to your job as soon as possible. When trying to schedule a day please be aware that we have to contend with the weather, jack hammering when necessary, and or material shortages at local wholesalers. Also we do make great efforts to install each job in the order in which it was received.
- 7:** If you would like to be there the day of install, please let your estimator know.
- 8:** Depending on the dips and slope of your yard (in order to maintain the look of the fence at the top) you may have some places that come off the ground. We recommend filling in dirt at the bottom if it is important for the fence to be close or on the ground. Some ground work may be required by you once your fence is installed.
- 9:** in some situation we will need to pull on the property with a vehicle, equipment or trailers. Some ground work may be required by you after construction has taken place on your property.
- 10:** If possible we like for you to be present at the beginning to ensure the fence is placed where you want it. Also at the end to walk and sign off on the job with the installers.

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
